Starters

"Uca" Favourite Russian fish soup.

"Kete" Salmon caviar served on a crushed ice base with Traditional Russian pancakes

"Smoked Salmon bliny" tender pieces of Smoked Salmon wrapped in
Traditional Russian pancakes and sprinkled with lemon juice

"Russian Hunter salad" smoked venison, roasted sweet peppers and green beans

"Siberian Pelmeny" homemade beef and pork ravioli, served with sour cream

"Mushroom julienne" pan fried wild mushrooms baked in a cream and cheese sauce (v)

Main Course

"Loses" salmon fillet grilled with bacon, wild mushrooms and truffle oil. This dish was
served to Tsar Nikolay II at his coronation banquet

"Russian Hot Pot" a mildly spiced tender pork casserole with potatoes, garlic, fresh
coriander, and black pepper, served in a traditional Russian clay pot

"Beef Provenca" tender strips of beef fillet, sauté in red wine, sour cream and onion
sauce, served with rice

"Saccory" Traditional Armenian dish, chicken breast sauté in rich herbed walnut sauce,
served with rice

"Solubry" cabbage leaf roll stuffed with risotto, carrot, parsnip, mushrooms and herbs(v)
All served with fresh vegetables

Desserts

"Napoleon" An exquisite Russian delight, a multi layered home made flaky pastry, filled
with delicious home made custard

"Swan lake" original recipe of meringue (1926), created in honour to Russian ballerina
Anna Pavlova topped with strawberries and passion fruit
